ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE BRIEF

Post-hearing briefs in this case were due to be filed with the Utilities Board (Board) on June 20, 2006. On June 21, 2006, MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) filed its brief and a request for leave to file it one day late. MidAmerican stated the courier service it used failed to deliver the brief to the Board prior to closing despite having been instructed to do so. MidAmerican stated that since there are no subsequent filings to be made by the parties, there would be no prejudice to any party from the late filing.

Since it appears that the late filing was due to an inadvertent error, the brief was filed only one day late, and there is no prejudice to any other party by the late filing, the request should be granted.
