**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME**

(Issued June 30, 2006)

On April 25, 2006, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a petition for a proceeding to consider a civil penalty for an alleged cramming violation committed by ILD Teleservices, Inc. (ILD). On June 8, 2006, ILD filed a motion to dismiss Consumer Advocate's petition. On June 16, 2006, Consumer Advocate filed a request for an extension of time in which to reply to ILD's motion to dismiss. Consumer Advocate asks that it be granted an extension of time to July 6, 2006, in which to respond to the motion to dismiss. Consumer Advocate states that ILD does not object to the extension. The Board finds the request reasonable and will grant the motion.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The motion for extension of time filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice in this docket on June 16, 2006, is granted. Consumer Advocate's response to the motion to dismiss filed by ILD Teleservices, Inc., shall be filed with the Board on or before July 6, 2006.
