ORDER DOCKETING TARIFF

(Issued July 17, 2006)

On June 30, 2006, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) proposed new interruptible tariff riders, identified as TF-06-197, that are to implement a non-unanimous settlement agreement and energy efficiency plan modification filed on the same date in Docket No. EEP-02-38. The proposed settlement and plan modification both relate to IPL's interruptible service.

Because of the substantial changes proposed in the tariff filing, non-unanimous settlement agreement, and plan modification, the Board needs additional time for review of the changes and supporting documentation. Therefore, the Board will docket the tariff for further investigation and suspend it. At this time, the Board does not anticipate that a procedural schedule will be necessary. If it becomes necessary to set a procedural schedule, the schedule will be set by subsequent order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Tariff filing TF-06-197 is docketed for further investigation and suspended.
