ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

(Issued July 24, 2006)

On June 28, 2006, OmniTel Communications, Inc. (OmniTel), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed amendment to its tariff that would allow OmniTel to provide competitive local exchange service in the Mason City, Iowa, exchange. Qwest Corporation (Qwest) is the incumbent local exchange carrier in Mason City. OmniTel requested a July 27, 2006, effective date for the tariff revision. Notice of the proposed change was sent to all affected carriers and no objections to the revision have been filed. The proposed tariff has been identified as TF-06-195.

Previously, on January 25, 2006, OmniTel filed a request to amend its certificate to allow it to provide local exchange service in exchanges listed in its tariff. In that filing, OmniTel agreed to concur in the exchange maps of Qwest and committed to using thousand-block number pooling (TBNP), even in areas where TBNP is voluntary, to the extent it is technically feasible to do so. The Board issued an order amending OmniTel's certificate on March 16, 2006, in Docket No. TCU-99-32.

The Board has reviewed the proposed tariff and finds that it substantially complies with Board rules for the filing and processing of tariff pages. Therefore, the Board will approve OmniTel's proposed tariff allowing OmniTel to provide competitive local exchange services in the Mason City exchange.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The proposed tariff filed by OmniTel Communications, Inc., on June 28, 2006, identified as TF-06-195, is approved and deemed effective July 27, 2006, as requested by OmniTel Communications, Inc.
