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**ORDER DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS COUNT II, ACKNOWLEDGING
WITHDRAWAL OF COUNT V, GRANTING MOTION PRO HAC VICE, AND
TAKING OFFICIAL NOTICE OF DOCUMENTS**

(Issued August 7, 2006)

On February 1, 2006, Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom (Iowa Telecom), filed a complaint including a request for declaratory order against South Slope Cooperative Telephone Company (South Slope).¹ On February 14, 2006, South Slope submitted a petition for intervention, a motion to dismiss the declaratory proceeding, a motion to sever the various counts of the complaint, and a motion for an expedited ruling regarding South Slope's obligation to file an answer (in addition to the motion to dismiss that was filed pursuant to 199 IAC 7.9(2)"c").

On March 2, 2006, the Board issued an order declining to issue a declaratory ruling and opened a complaint proceeding. In that order, the Board directed South Slope to file an answer to the complaint and effectively denied South Slope's motion to dismiss Count II of the proceeding by indicating that it would be considered in the formal contested complaint proceeding.²

Motion to Dismiss

On July 10, 2006, South Slope renewed its motion to dismiss Count II of the complaint arguing that Iowa Telecom's request that South Slope conform its Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) entries to associate the numbering resources that it uses to serve customers is nothing more than local number portability (LNP) implementation between Iowa Telecom and South Slope. South Slope argues this is a dispute that should be determined by the North American Numbering Council subject to review by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

In its resistance to the renewed motion to dismiss, filed July 24, 2006, Iowa Telecom argues the matters raised in Count II pertain not to new LNP deployment rules for unique circumstances but to the straightforward application of existing FCC rules, Board rules, and industry standards.

In reviewing the testimony filed by both parties regarding Count II, it appears that although both parties testify extensively about LERG entries, the primary complaint relates to a service territory dispute between two utilities. South Slope

contends the Board approved a rate center consolidation when it granted South Slope a certificate to serve the Oxford, Solon, and Tiffin exchanges. Iowa Telecom argues that South Slope has never requested rate center consolidation from the Board.

The Board has clear authority to resolve service territory disputes pursuant to its rules. Subrule 199 IAC 22.20(2) states that "inappropriate overlaps in service territories are to be avoided." Additionally, 199 IAC 22.20(2)"d" states that "if utilities cannot agree on the boundary ... the board will resolve the issues in contested case proceedings to revise the maps and modify the certificates ... " The Board denies the motion to dismiss Count II of the complaint.

Dismissal of Count V

On July 24, 2006, Iowa Telecom filed a dismissal of Count V of the complaint, without prejudice. The Board acknowledges this dismissal of Count V.

Pro Hac Vice Request

On July 17, 2006, South Slope filed an application for admission pro hac vice requesting the Board admit Benjamin H. Dickens, Jr. to appear as counsel on its behalf in this proceeding. Mr. Dickens is an attorney with the law firm of Blooston, Mordkofsky, Dickens, Duffy & Prendergast, Washington, D.C., and is a member of the bar of the District of Columbia and the bar of the state of Florida. Mr. Dickens is admitted to practice before the U.S. Court of Appeals, District of Columbia Circuit. There is an appearance of an Iowa-resident attorney upon whom service may be made.

The Board will grant this request and admit Mr. Dickens, pro hac vice for the purpose of appearing on behalf of South Slope in this proceeding. The request complies with 199 IAC 7.4(8)"a" and Iowa Admission to the Bar rule 31.14(2).
