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**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION**

(Issued August 10, 2006)

On August 1, 2006, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed a motion for extension of time to file the report required by 199 IAC 19.11(6). Subrule 19.11(6) requires a rate-regulated natural gas utility to file an executive summary and index of all standard and special contracts in effect for the purchase, sale, or exchange of gas on or before August 1 each year. IPL states it has experienced recent changes in personnel that have resulted in the internal reassignment of duties. These reassignments prevent IPL from preparing a complete and accurate executive summary for filing by the date required in the subrule. IPL requests an extension of time to file the updates to August 15, 2006.

The Board will grant IPL's request. Filing of the information by August 15, 2006, should give the Board and other interested persons sufficient opportunity to review the executive summary and request any additional information needed from IPL.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The request for extension of time filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on August 1, 2006, is granted. The executive summary required by 199 IAC 19.11(6) is now due on August 15, 2006.
