**ORDER GRANTING ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE**

(Issued August 25, 2006)

On August 10, 2006, Susan J. Frye and Bret Dublinske, Iowa attorneys representing Intervenor Guthrie Telecommunications, Inc. (Guthrie), in this proceeding, filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to allow out-of-state attorney David Cosson to appear as attorney on behalf of Guthrie. Attached to the request is an affidavit in which Mr. Cosson states he is licensed to practice law in the District of Columbia, is a member in good standing of the bar of that jurisdiction, and agrees to comply with all provisions of the Iowa Code of Professional Responsibility.
