**TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT**

(Issued August 31, 2006)

On July 20, 2006, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a verified petition for franchise with an application for a temporary construction permit pursuant to Iowa Code § 478.31 (2005), for .82 miles of 72,500 maximum voltage electric transmission line in Jones County, Iowa.

In support of its request, IPL asserted it has obtained the approval of the appropriate highway or railroad authorities, and is the nearest electric utility to the proposed point of service.

The Board has reviewed IPL's application and finds it meets the requirements of Iowa Code § 478.31 (2005). Therefore, IPL is granted a temporary construction permit for an electric transmission line to be operated at a maximum voltage not in excess of that stated herein and not exceeding one mile in length over, along, and across the following described land, highways, and streams:

East Terminus is the Interstate Power and Light Company (IP&L) Amber substation located in the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of Section 34, T-85N, R-3W, Jones County, Iowa.

West Terminus is an electrical connection to an existing IP&L transmission line located in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 4, T-84N, R-3W. The line

ultimately terminates at an IP&L substation located with the corporation limits of Anamosa, Iowa.

Beginning at the Interstate Power and Light Company (IP&L) Amber substation located in the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of Section 34, T-85N, R-3W of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Jones County, Iowa, thence Southwesterly .08 mile on public right of way and crossing County Road X44 to a point in the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 3, T-84N, R-3W, thence West .74 mile on public right of way in the south margin of 130 Street and near the north line of Sections 3 and 4 to an electrical connection with an existing IP&L transmission line located in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 4, all in the last named township and range.

If the Board determines that a franchise should not be granted, or that further restrictions, conditions or modifications are required, or if IPL fails to make a sufficient and proper showing of the necessity for granting the franchise within six months of the granting of this temporary construction permit, this permit shall become null and void.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The application for a temporary construction permit filed by Interstate Power and Light Company, on July 20, 2006, is granted in accordance with the body of this order.
