ORDER CANCELLING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND REQUIRING REPORT

(Issued September 5, 2006)

On August 30, 2006, Midwest Renewable Energy Projects LLC, Interstate Power and Light Company, and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (collectively, "The Parties") filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a joint motion to revise the procedural schedule on rehearing in Docket No. AEP-05-1. The Parties state the motion is being filed in order to allow the Parties additional time to complete another Electric Generation Expansion Analysis System (EGEAS) analysis as addressed in the Board's August 25, 2006, order. The Parties ask that the current procedural schedule be cancelled and a new one established. The Parties state that they will file a joint report on September 7, 2006, indicating the approximate time frames necessary to complete the analysis; the Parties contemplate that the Board will set a new procedural schedule after reviewing the report.

The Board will grant the motion in order to allow more time for completion and review of the additional EGEAS analysis. The current procedural schedule is cancelled. The Board will set a new schedule after reviewing the September 7, 2006, joint report.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The "Joint Motion to Revise Procedural Schedule" filed by Midwest Renewable Energy Projects LLC, Interstate Power and Light Company, and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice on August 30, 2006, is granted.
2. The procedural schedule established in the Board's June 29, 2006, order is cancelled.
3. The parties shall file a joint report on the status of the updated analysis on or before September 7, 2006.
