SECOND ORDER MODIFYING POST-HEARING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

(Issued September 13, 2006)

The hearing for this case was held on August 1, 2006. An "Order Setting Post-Hearing Schedule" was issued August 3, 2006. Among other things, the order set deadlines of September 1, 2006, for the filing of initial post-hearing briefs and September 21, 2006, for the filing of post-hearing reply briefs.

On August 15, 2006, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a motion to modify the briefing schedule by moving the deadlines back two weeks. MCI, Inc. (MCI) concurred in the motion. The motion was granted in an order issued August 17, 2006. Initial briefs were due on September 15, 2006, and reply briefs were due on October 5, 2006.

On September 12, 2006, the Consumer Advocate filed a request for a seven-day extension of the deadline to file initial and reply briefs. The Consumer Advocate

stated good cause existed for the extension due to the Consumer Advocate's extremely full schedule and other matters that have required more attention than anticipated. MCI concurs in requesting the one-week extension.

The Consumer Advocate's request for a seven-day extension appears to be reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The parties shall file initial post-hearing briefs on or before September 22, 2006.
2. The parties shall file post-hearing reply briefs on or before October 12, 2006.
3. All provisions of the "Order Setting Post-Hearing Schedule" issued August 3, 2006, and the "Order Regarding Post-Hearing Exhibits" issued August 31, 2006, not specifically modified by this order remain in effect.
