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**ORDER GRANTING AUTHORITY TO COMMENCE SERVICE AS A
COMPETITIVE NATURAL GAS PROVIDER**

(Issued September 27, 2006)

On August 31, 2006, Coral Energy Resources, L.P. (Coral), filed an application for a certificate as a competitive natural gas provider (CNGP) with the Utilities Board (Board). On September 22, 2006, the Board issued an order granting the application to provide service to large volume customers and Certificate No. G-0018. In the September 22, 2006, order the Board directed that Coral could not commence service in Iowa until it had filed a copy of the Certificate of Authority to conduct business in Iowa from the Iowa Secretary of State.

On September 25, 2006, Coral filed supplemental information about the Certificate of Authority and requested authorization to commence service as soon as possible. Coral explains that the Secretary of State has not issued a Certificate of Authority because of a backlog. Coral provided a copy of information downloaded from the Secretary of State Web site showing that Coral is authorized to do business in Iowa as a foreign limited partnership effective August 24, 2006.

The Board has considered the information provided by Coral and finds that it is sufficient to demonstrate that Coral is authorized to conduct business in Iowa. Coral may begin providing competitive natural gas service under Certificate No. G-0018 on the date of this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Coral Energy Resources, L.P., may commence service as a competitive natural gas provider under Certificate No. G-0018 on the date of this order.
