ORDER WITHDRAWING APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

(Issued October 5, 2006)

On June 1, 2001, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. TCU-01-8 approving the application of KMC DATA, LLC (KMC), to provide local exchange service in Iowa. In that order, the Board stated that a certificate would be issued to KMC when it had an approved tariff showing the rates, terms, and conditions of the service it would be providing. Because KMC has not filed tariffs for Board approval, the Board has not issued a certificate to KMC.

In a letter dated September 14, 2006, KMC's parent company, KMC Telecom Holdings, Inc., notified the Board of the dissolution of KMC Telecom Holdings, Inc. Based on that notification, the Board understands that KMC no longer plans to offer local exchange service in Iowa. The Board will withdraw its approval of KMC's application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. KMC or any related entity may re-apply for a certificate at anytime.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The Board withdraws its approval of the application for public convenience and necessity filed by KMC DATA, LLC, and approved by Board order issued June 1, 2001.
