ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued October 19, 2006)

On October 16, 2006, Midwest Renewable Energy Projects LLC (MREP) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a motion for a two-day extension of the time for MREP and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) to file their direct testimony.
