ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

(Issued October 23, 2006)

On October 13, 2006, the Community Coalition for Rate Fairness (CCRF) filed a petition with the Utilities Board (Board) to intervene in Docket No. RPU-06-1. This docket involves Interstate Power and Light Company's (IPL) proposal for consolidation of lighting tariffs and second-step rate equalization. No objections to the petition to intervene have been filed.

In support of its petition to intervene, the CCRF states that its membership includes cities, hospitals, and large industries. All of its members are IPL electric customers located in either the Northern rate zone or the Southeastern rate zone and some of its members are among IPL's largest electric customers. A list of current CCRF members was attached to the petition to intervene.

The Board will grant the petition to intervene. The CCRF has alleged a unique interest in this proceeding that is not currently represented. The CCRF's testimony can be expected to assist in the development of a thorough evidentiary record.

The petition to intervene filed by the Community Coalition for Rate Fairness on October 13, 2006, is granted.
