**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND CANCELLING HEARING**

(Issued December 4, 2006)

On November 30, 2006, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a "Request to Suspend Procedural Schedule and Cancel Hearing in Anticipation of Settlement." In support of the request, IPL said that after reviewing testimony filed to date in Docket No. RPU-06-1, IPL did not discern any issues of significant controversy. IPL stated it contacted all parties to the proceeding and the parties expressed an interest in pursuing settlement. IPL asks that the hearing scheduled for January 23, 2007, be canceled and the procedural schedule be suspended.

The Board will suspend the procedural schedule and cancel the hearing. IPL's request represents that none of the parties objects to suspension of the procedural schedule or cancellation of the hearing. In the event a hearing is necessary, it will be rescheduled by subsequent Board order. The parties will be required to file a joint report regarding the status of settlement negotiations (if no proposed settlement has been filed with the Board) on or before December 22, 2006.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The procedural schedule in Docket No. RPU-06-1 is suspended and the hearing scheduled to begin on January 23, 2007, is cancelled.

2. The parties shall file a joint report on the status of settlement negotiations on or before December 22, 2006.
