**ORDER REJECTING TARIFF AND DENYING CERTIFICATE  
WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

(Issued December 13, 2006)

On June 3, 2004, Trans National Communications International, Inc. (TNCI), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in Iowa. The application was identified as Docket No. TCU-04-8 and, on July 20, 2004, the Board issued an order granting the application and explaining it would issue a certificate when TNCI filed an approved tariff.

On September 26, 2006 TNCI filed a tariff in order to provide local exchange service in the exchanges currently served by Qwest Corporation. The proposed tariff was identified as TF-06-256. Board staff reviewed the proposed tariff and found it does not comply with the Board's requirements for content of tariffs. Staff contacted TNCI on several occasions to recommend changes to the tariff to bring it into compliance with the Board's tariff. TNCI agreed to file revisions, but the revisions have not been filed.

Consequently, the Board will reject the tariff filed in this docket by TNCI on September 26, 2006, for failure to comply with the Board's requirements for content of tariffs and will deny TNCI's request for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, without prejudice. TNCI can obtain a certificate when it files a tariff that complies with the Board's requirements for content of tariffs.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The proposed tariff filed by Trans National Communications International, Inc., on September 26, 2006, identified as TF-06-256, is rejected.

2. The request for a certificate of public convenience and necessity filed on June 3, 2004, by Trans National Communications International, Inc., identified as Docket No. TCU-04-8, is denied, without prejudice.
