ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR DETERMINATION

(Issued December 22, 2006)

On October 4, 2006, My Tel Co., Inc. (My Tel), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29 (2005), stating its intention to provide local exchange service in Iowa. The application was identified as Docket No. TCU-06-8.

Also on October 4, 2006, My Tel filed a proposed tariff in order to provide local exchange service in Iowa. The proposed tariff was identified as TF-06-277.

Iowa Code § 476.29(2) provides:

The board shall make a determination within ninety days of the submission by the applicant of evidence of its technical, financial, and managerial ability, unless the board determines that additional time is necessary to consider the application, in which case the board may extend the time for making a determination for an additional sixty days.

Upon review of My Tel's application and tariff, Board staff has determined that neither the application nor the tariff, as filed, fully comply with the Board's requirements for applications and content of tariffs. Staff contacted My Tel and discussed the corrections and revisions that would be necessary in order for the

application and tariff to comply with the Board's requirements. My Tel has indicated to Board staff that it would be submitting the necessary revisions, but due to staff changes within My Tel, those revisions have not been filed. My Tel requests the Board exercise its discretion under § 476.29(2) and extend the time for making a determination on My Tel's application and tariff an additional 60 days to allow My Tel to file the necessary revisions.

According to § 476.29(2), in the absence of an extension a determination regarding My Tel's application must be made within 90 days, or on or before January 2, 2007. Based on My Tel's representation that it intends to file revisions to its application and tariff, the Board will grant My Tel's request and extend the time for making a determination regarding My Tel's application and tariff by 60 days as allowed pursuant to § 476.29(2). To ensure that the Board has ample time to review My Tel's revisions, the Board will require My Tel to file its revisions to its application and tariff within 30 days of the date of this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The Board extends the time to make a determination regarding the application for public convenience and necessity and proposed local exchange tariff filed by My Tel Co, Inc., on October 4, 2006, an additional 60 days pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29(2), as described in the body of this order.

2. My Tel Co, Inc., shall file revisions to its application and public convenience and necessity and proposed local exchange tariff within 30 days of the date of this order.
