ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS AND WAIVER

(Issued February 27, 2007)

On January 30, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) proposed tariffs, identified as TF-07-20 (gas) and TF-07-21 (electric). IPL filed revisions to the proposed tariffs on February 14 and 20, 2007. The proposed tariffs revise IPL's energy efficiency cost recovery factors for the 12-month period beginning March 1, 2007. No objections to the proposed tariffs were filed.

The Board will approve the proposed tariffs. The proposed tariffs reflect projected energy efficiency expenditures for the next 12 months, as well as a reconciliation of the past year's expenditures to compensate for any over- or under-recovery. The cost recovery factors will decrease slightly for all classes (both electric and gas) except lighting, where the energy efficiency cost recovery factor will remain constant.

IPL requested an effective date of March 1, 2007, for the proposed tariff. Subrule 199 IAC 35.12(2) provides that customer billing for new energy efficiency

cost recovery factors is not to begin until the first billing month at least 30 days following Board approval. The March 1 starting date is consistent with IPL's past practice and allows future recoveries to be on a contemporaneous basis, providing more pricing certainty both to IPL and its customers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Tariff filings TF-07-120 and TF-07-21, filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on January 30, 2007, and as revised on February 14 and 20, 2007, are approved, subject to complaint or investigation, effective March 1, 2007.

2. Subrule 199 IAC 35.12(2) is waived to the extent necessary to allow TF-07-20 and TF-07-21 to become effective on March 1, 2007.
