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**ORDER CHANGING REPORTING REQUIREMENT**

(Issued March 8, 2007)

On March 5, 2007, the parties in this case, Progressive Foundry, Inc., Interstate Power and Light Company, Jacobsen Holz Corporation, and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice, filed a joint status report and a request for quarterly status reports. The parties request that the schedule for filing status reports be changed from once every two months to once per quarter, with the next status report due on June 29, 2007. The parties state that by June 29, they should be able to report on the success of their planned installation of new capacitors.

The purpose of the status reports is to keep the undersigned administrative law judge and the Board informed of the parties' activities in pursuing a solution.

Quarterly status reports will serve this function. Therefore, the parties' request should be granted. The parties' request to have the next status report due June 29, 2007, is reasonable and should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The order issued August 9, 2005, requiring the parties to file status reports with the Board every two months is rescinded.
2. The parties must file the next two quarterly status reports on or before June 29, 2007, and October 1, 2007.
3. Thereafter, the parties must file quarterly status reports with the Board on or before January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1 of each year until otherwise ordered.
