ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

(Issued March 15, 2007)

On March 4, 2004, the Utilities Board (Board) issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity to SBC Long Distance, LLC, d/b/a SBC Long Distance, d/b/a AT&T Long Distance (SBC), identified as Certificate No. 0278, authorizing SBC to provide local telecommunications service in Iowa.

On March 5, 2007, SBC filed a request to cancel its existing certificate. SBC requests the cancellation due to changes in its business plan. SBC states that it currently has no local exchange customers in Iowa and therefore a cancellation of its certificate will not result in a negative impact on the public. SBC asserts that it will continue to provide interexchange services.

The Board finds that cancellation of SBC's certificate is reasonable since SBC is not providing local exchange service in Iowa and does not have any local exchange customers. If SBC's business plan changes and it elects to begin providing local service in Iowa in the future, SBC may reapply for certification.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The request of SBC Long Distance, LLC, d/b/a SBC Long Distance, d/b/a AT&T Long Distance, to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity, Certificate No. 0278, filed March 5, 2007, is granted.
