**ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL AND
SUBSTITUTION OF COUNSEL**

(Issued March 30, 2007)

On August 12, 2004, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in this docket approving a settlement agreement filed by Iowa Joint Utility Management Program, Inc. (IJUMP), Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate), and MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican). The settlement agreement provided for the expansion of the pilot programs of IPL and MidAmerican for the transportation of natural gas by small volume customers. Cornerstone Energy, Inc. (Cornerstone), filed a pleading supporting the settlement.

On March 14, 2007, Nancy S. Boyd and James L. Pray of the law firm Brown, Winick, Graves, Gross, Baskerville & Schoenebaum, P.L.C., filed a request to withdraw as counsel for Cornerstone. Service in this docket for Cornerstone in the future is to be sent to Richard Haubensak.

On March 26, 2007, IJUMP filed a request that the law firm of Cronin Smith, PLC, be substituted for the law firm of Brick, Gentry, Bowers, Swartz, Stoltze & Lewis, P.C., to represent IJUMP in this docket.

The Board acknowledges the change in representation of Cornerstone and IJUMP in this docket and the official service list will be revised accordingly.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Service in this docket on Cornerstone Energy, Inc., shall now be on Richard Haubensak.
2. The law firm of Cronin Smith, PLC, will now represent Iowa Joint Utility Management Program, Inc., in this docket.
