**ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME AND REQUIRING REPORT**

(Issued April 2, 2007)

On March 15, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), the Iowa Consumers Coalition, and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (collectively, the "Parties") filed a "Joint Report" on the status of various issues related to IPL's proposed "Standby and Supplementary Power Service" tariff. The Parties reported that they had resolved two of the three issues and filed proposed tariff language containing their agreement. The Parties requested an additional 30 days to continue discussions regarding the third issue.

The Board will grant the additional time for discussions and require the Parties to file a second joint report on or before April 17, 2007. The Board is reviewing the tariff revisions proposed by the Parties and will rule on those revisions at the appropriate time.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The joint request for additional time for the Parties to continue discussions on the outstanding issue in Docket No. TF-06-336 is granted.

2. The Parties shall file a second joint report on or before April 17, 2007, detailing the status of the discussions.
