ORDER APPROVING CUSTOMER NOTICES

(Issued April 6, 2007)

On March 16, 2007, Iowa-American Water Company (Iowa-American) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request for approval of a proposed rate increase notification pursuant to 199 IAC 26.5(1)"d"(1), which requires that nonstandard notification forms be approved by the Board. Iowa-American submitted proposed rate notices with its request. Counsel for the Board contacted counsel for the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) and Consumer Advocate has no objection to the rate notices. No objections to the proposed rate increase notification were filed.

The only change to the standard notice set forth in 199 IAC 26.5(1)"c" is that Iowa-American is proposing two separate rate notices, one for its Clinton district and the other for its Quad-Cities district; rates are different in the two districts. The notices sent to each district will only contain the rate and percentage increase information applicable to that district.

The Board will approve the notices. The notice for each district generally conforms to the information required in the Board's standard notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The proposed rate increase notice forms filed by Iowa-American Water Company on March 16, 2007, are approved.
