ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

(Issued April 16, 2007)

On June 6, 2006, the city of Titonka, Iowa (Titonka), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a petition requesting a certificate of authority to furnish electric service to the existing point of delivery of customers already receiving electric service from another electric utility. Titonka is an Iowa municipal corporation presently receiving electric service from Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL). IPL owns the electric distribution system within Titonka.

On April 10, 2007, IPL and Titonka filed a stipulation for dismissal of the proceedings. The Board will dismiss the docket pursuant to the stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Pursuant to the stipulation filed on April 10, 2007, by the city of Titonka, Iowa, and Interstate Power and Light Company, Docket No. SPU-06-9 is dismissed.
