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REVISED PROCEDURAL ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

(Issued April 19, 2007)

On January 19, 2007, the City of Sioux Center (Sioux Center) filed a petition and exhibits with the Utilities Board (Board) for a pipeline permit. On April 11, 2007, the undersigned administrative law judge issued the "Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Proposing to Take Official Notice and Notice of Hearing." On April 18, 2007, Sioux Center filed a motion to change the procedural schedule and hearing date. In the motion, Sioux Center stated it needed to proceed with the project, requested an expedited hearing date, and waived its right to file rebuttal testimony. Sioux Center stated it understood the requirements regarding publication of notice and would comply with them. The Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) does not object to moving the hearing date. No objections have been filed in the case. The motion is reasonable and should be granted, although the undersigned is unavailable on the requested hearing date of May 14, 2007.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The following amended procedural schedule is established:
 - a. On or before April 26, 2007, Sioux Center must file prepared direct testimony and exhibits regarding its petition for a permit as discussed in the April 11, 2007, procedural order. If Sioux Center chooses to file a prehearing brief, it must be filed by April 26, 2007.
 - b. If the Consumer Advocate or any objector chooses to file prepared responsive testimony or a brief, it must do so on or before May 4, 2007.
 - c. A public hearing for the presentation of evidence and the cross-examination of witnesses concerning the issues identified in this notice of hearing will be held beginning at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, May 15, 2007, in Board Conference Room 3, 350 Maple Street, Des Moines, Iowa. Each party must provide a copy of its prepared testimony and exhibits to the court reporter at the hearing. If any party wishes to be connected to the hearing by telephone conference call or have a witness connected by telephone conference call, the party must notify the Board as soon as possible, and no later than Friday, May 4, 2007, so that appropriate arrangements may be made. Persons with disabilities who will require assistive services or devices to observe this hearing or participate in it should contact the Board at (515) 281-5256 no later

than five days prior to the hearing to request that appropriate arrangements be made.

2. All provisions of the "Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Proposing to Take Official Notice and Notice of Hearing," issued April 11, 2007, remain in effect unless specifically modified by this order. Sioux Center must take care to comply with all requirements set forth in the order, including the number of copies of documents required to be filed with the Board.
