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**NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF APPROVAL OF  
APPLICATION OR MODIFICATION**

(Issued April 24, 2007)

On January 5, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) mailed annual report forms to each of the local exchange carriers possessing (or approved for) a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide service in Iowa, pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29 (2007). The forms were mailed to the carriers at the addresses on file with the Board.

Attachment A, attached to this order, identifies 8 competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs) that have been approved for certificates, but have never filed the tariffs or maps required to actually obtain a certificate. An annual report has not been received from any of the carriers identified on Attachment A.

Attachment B, also attached to this order, identifies four CLECs that have requested a modification of their existing certificates, but have never filed the tariffs or maps required to complete the amendment process.

On the basis of this information, it appears the carriers identified in Attachment A are not providing landline local telephone service in Iowa and should

not be permitted to continue to hold an approved application for that purpose. In addition, it appears the carriers identified in Attachment B no longer require a modification or amendment to their certificates. Therefore, within 30 days from the date of this order, the Board's approvals for the applications for certificates and modifications of certificates issued to each of the carriers identified in Attachments A and B will be cancelled without further action by the Board unless the Board is contacted by the carrier and provided with information regarding the carrier's plans for filing a proposed tariff and/or maps or otherwise completing the process of obtaining or modifying a certificate.

Any carrier providing updated information should file the information in the TCU docket in which the carrier's application was approved. If a carrier makes a timely filing as described above, its approved application will not be canceled at this time.

Finally, the Board will direct that a copy of this order be mailed to each of the carriers shown on Attachments A and B at the carrier's last known address and another copy placed in each of the listed TCU files maintained in the Board's Records Center.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The carriers identified in Attachments A and B are directed to contact the Board with updated corporate information within 30 days of the date of this order. If the Board does not receive a response from a particular carrier within 30 days of the

date of this order, the approved application issued to that carrier by the Board will be deemed canceled without any further action by the Board.
