**ORDER WITHDRAWING APPROVAL OF APPLICATION**

(Issued April 26, 2007)

On July 21, 2000, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. TCU-00-23, approving the application of DIECA Communications, Inc., d/b/a Covad Communications Company (Covad), to provide local exchange service in Iowa. In that order, the Board stated that a certificate would be issued to Covad to commence service when it had on file an approved tariff showing the rates, terms, and conditions of the service it would be providing.

On April 19, 2007, Covad submitted a letter to the Board requesting withdrawal of its approved application. Covad states that it no longer has plans to provide competitive local exchange service in Iowa. The Board notes that Covad does not have an approved tariff on file with the Board, nor is there a record of the Board issuing a certificate to Covad following the Board's July 21, 2000, order.

Based on the information provided in Covad's April 19, 2007, notice, the Board will withdraw its approval of Covad's application. Covad has not established local service in Iowa, nor does it have any Iowa customers who would be affected by this

withdrawal. Covad may file for a new certificate if it decides to offer a local exchange service in Iowa.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The Board withdraws its approval of the application for public convenience and necessity filed by DIECA Communications, Inc., d/b/a Covad Communications Company, and approved by Board order issued July 21, 2000, without prejudice.
