ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

(Issued May 7, 2007)

On April 23, 2007, Ag Processing Inc (Ag Processing) filed a petition with the Utilities Board (Board) to intervene in Docket No. SPU-07-11. This docket involves a proposed reorganization in which Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) seeks to sell and transfer its electric transmission assets to ITC Midwest LLC. No objections to the petition were filed.

In support of its petition to intervene, Ag Processing states that is an electric customer of IPL involved in processing soybeans and refining soybean oil. Ag Processing further states that the cost of energy has a significant impact on its cost of doing business and that IPL's proposal directly impacts Ag Processing's cost of energy.

The Board will grant the petition to intervene. Ag Processing has alleged a unique interest in this proceeding that is not currently represented.

The petition to intervene filed by Ag Processing Inc on April 23, 2007, is granted.
