**ORDER APPROVING CHANGES TO EXCHANGE BOUNDARY MAPS**

(Issued May 10, 2007)

On May 1, 2007, Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom (Iowa Telecom), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to change its exchange boundary map for its Ainsworth, Riverside, and Columbus Junction, Iowa, exchanges. The filing has been identified as TF-07-96.

Iowa Telecom proposes to transfer a limited area of the Ainsworth exchange to the Riverside exchange. Iowa Telecom states that a new home is being built on the edge of the Ainsworth exchange, but the closest facilities that will support digital subscriber line (DSL) service, a service requested by the new homeowner, are located in the Riverside exchange. Iowa Telecom states that no other customers would be affected by this change. Iowa Telecom also states that revisions to the Ainsworth and Riverside boundaries would require a revision to the Columbus Junction boundary map because the point of intersection for the three exchanges would change.

The Board will approve the proposed changes to the Ainsworth, Riverside, and Columbus Junction, Iowa, exchange boundaries submitted by Iowa Telecom

pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29(8). The Board finds that the change is reasonable since the boundary revision was initiated in order to use the network more efficiently and no current customers will be affected by this change. Iowa Telecom's request merely changes the boundaries of current exchanges covered by Iowa Telecom's certificate. Therefore, an amended certificate is not needed.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The request to change the exchange boundary maps for the Ainsworth, Riverside, and Columbus Junction, Iowa, exchanges filed by Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom, on May 1, 2007, is granted.
2. Revised maps for the Ainsworth, Riverside, and Columbus Junction, Iowa, exchanges shall be filed with the Board within 30 days of the date of this order.
3. The proposed changes, identified as TF-07-96, are approved and become effective upon the issuance of this order.
