ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

(Issued May 23, 2007)

On March 23, 2007, Aventure Communication Technology, L.L.C. (Aventure), filed a petition with the Utilities Board (Board) requesting the Board arbitrate an interconnection agreement between Aventure and Mutual Telephone Company (Mutual). The petition was filed pursuant to the provisions of Board rules 199 IAC 38.4(3) and 38.7(3) and § 252(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Pub. L. No. 101-104, 110 Stat. 56 (1996) (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"). The petition has been identified as Docket No. ARB-07-1.

On April 2, 2007, the Board issued an order docketing Aventure's petition and setting a telephone conference pursuant to 199 IAC 38.7(3)"g." A telephone conference took place as scheduled on April 11, 2007.

On April 23, 2007, the parties filed with the Board a negotiated interconnection agreement, identified as Docket No. NIA-07-14. Rule 38.7(4)"d" provides that any interested party may submit written comments with the Board supporting either acceptance or rejection of the agreement within 30 days of the date the agreement was filed. No comments have been received.

In addition, paragraph 38.7(4)"d" provides that "[I]f no comments are filed and no issues are generated by the internal board review, the agreement . . . shall be deemed approved 41 days after the filing date." Because no comments have been received and no issues were generated by the Board's review of this agreement, the negotiated interconnection agreement was deemed approved by operation of law and the Board may close this arbitration proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

This arbitration docket, identified as Docket No. ARB-07-1, is closed.
