**ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION**

(Issued June 11, 2007)

On June 1, 2007, Ag Processing Inc (Ag Processing) filed a petition with the Utilities Board (Board) to intervene in Docket No. RPU-07-2. This docket involves MidAmerican Energy Company's (MidAmerican) application for determination of ratemaking principles, including the proposed settlement agreement for MidAmerican's proposed Wind IV Iowa Projects. No objections to the petition to intervene were filed.

In support of its petition to intervene, Ag Processing states that it is an industrial electric customer of MidAmerican involved in processing soybeans and refining soybean oil. Ag Processing further states that the cost of energy has a significant impact on its cost of doing business and that issues presented by the application and settlement will impact Ag Processing's cost of energy.

The Board will grant the petition to intervene. Ag Processing has alleged a unique interest in this proceeding that is not currently represented.

The petition to intervene filed by Ag Processing Inc on June 1, 2007, is granted.
