ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

(Issued June 14, 2007)

The hearing in this case was held on June 12, 2007. At the hearing, the parties agreed to file copies of the exhibits introduced at hearing with the Utilities Board's Records and Information Center. Evercom Systems, Inc. (Evercom) agreed to file requests for confidentiality pursuant to 199 IAC 1.9 for testimony and exhibits it claims should be held confidential that have not been the subject of a previous request. In addition, the parties agreed to the following briefing schedule. The attorney for the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) stated he might need to request a short delay of the first date depending on the press of other business.
