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ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

(Issued June 27, 2007)

On May 29, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) its compliance electric tariff sheets regarding lighting consolidation (TF-06-254) and step two of rate equalization (TF-06-255), consistent with the final decision and order of the Board issued on February 14, 2007, in Docket No. RPU-06-1. The lighting consolidation tariff reflects IPL's consolidation of lighting rate structures and tariffs across its former pricing zones. The tariff addressing step two of rate equalization is the second step of rate equalization for all other customer classes under a consolidated rate structure. No objections to the proposed tariffs were filed.

The Board has reviewed the compliance tariff sheets and finds that they are consistent with the Board's final decision and order. The Board will approve the compliance tariffs. The tariffs are essentially identical to the tariff sheets accompanying IPL's initial filing in Docket No. RPU-06-1 on September 8, 2006; the only substantive change is that the new lighting rate design will become effective with

bills rendered on and after June 30, 2007, rather than usage on and after June 30, 2007. IPL explained that this change is necessary because its billing system cannot pro-rate customer usage between the old and new rate structures.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Compliance tariff sheets filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on May 29, 2007, identified as TF-06-254 and TF-06-255, are approved, effective with bills rendered on and after June 30, 2007, and subject to complaint or investigation.
