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ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFF

(Issued June 27, 2007)

On May 29, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) its compliance electric tariff sheet implementing step two of the four-step plan to equalize the credits paid to IPL's interruptible electric customers. The tariff sheet is identified as TF-07-109 and is intended to implement the Board's order approving settlement issued on October 20, 2006, in Docket No. EEP-02-38. The settlement approved by the Board sets out the four-step interruptible schedule by rate code and the dollar per kilowatt amounts to be used to calculate interruptible credits in both summer and winter. No objections to the proposed tariff were filed.

The Board has reviewed the compliance tariff and finds that it is consistent with the Board's order approving settlement. The Board will approve the compliance tariff. The tariff appropriately incorporates the step two rates contained in the settlement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The compliance tariff filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on May 29, 2007, identified as TF-07-109, is approved, effective June 30, 2007, subject to complaint or investigation.
