**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME**

(Issued June 29, 2007)

On June 27, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order requiring Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) and ITC Midwest LLC (ITC Midwest), collectively "Applicants," to file certain additional information to facilitate the Board's review of the Applicants' proposal for reorganization pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 476.76 and 476.77 (2007) and 199 IAC 32 to allow IPL to sell and transfer its electric transmission assets to ITC Midwest. The order required the additional information to be filed on or before July 7, 2007; a hearing on the proposed reorganization is scheduled to begin on August 1, 2007.

On June 28, 2007, IPL filed a motion for extension of time to file the additional information. IPL committed to file the information, which relates to cost-benefit analyses and the transfer of 34.5 kV electric lines, by July 17, 2007. In support of the extension, IPL said it is in the midst of preparing rebuttal testimony (due July 6, 2007) and that it cannot provide the information the Board requested within ten days.

The Board will grant the extension. However, the Board does not intend to grant any additional extension because the Board and other parties need an adequate opportunity to review the information prior to hearing.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The request for extension of time filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on June 28, 2007, is granted. Applicants shall provide the information identified in the Board's June 27, 2007, order, on or before July 17, 2007.
