ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION

(Issued July 9, 2007)

On July 9, 2007, Ames Municipal Electric System (Ames) filed a motion requesting that the due date to file post-hearing briefs be changed to July 13, 2007. Ames stated that the attorneys for the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) and the City of Huxley do not object to the request.
