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ORDER MODIFYING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

(Issued July 12, 2007)

On June 14, 2007, the undersigned administrative law judge issued an order setting the post-hearing briefing schedule for this case. On July 10, 2007, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a request to modify the briefing schedule by moving all deadlines back two weeks. The Consumer Advocate stated it needed additional time for brief preparation due to other scheduling demands and that Evercom Systems, Inc. (Evercom) had no objection. The request is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. On or before July 27, 2007, the Consumer Advocate must file its initial post-hearing brief.
2. On or before August 21, 2007, Evercom must file its post-hearing brief.

3. On or before September 11, 2007, the Consumer Advocate must file its post-hearing reply brief.
