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| IN RE: MIDAMERICAN ENERGY COMPANY | DOCKET NO. TF-07-140 (SPU-04-1) |
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ORDER APPROVING TARIFF EXTENDING PILOT PROGRAM

(Issued August 29, 2007)

On August 12, 2004, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order approving a settlement agreement in Docket No. SPU-04-1, In re: Iowa Joint Utility Management Program, Inc. The settlement agreement expanded the existing small volume gas pilot project to include state and local governmental entities and extended the project to August 31, 2007. On May 14, 2007, the Board issued an order granting a motion filed by Iowa Joint Utility Management Program, Inc., to extend the pilot programs for MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) and Interstate Power and Light Company to April 30, 2008.

On July 27, 2007, MidAmerican filed a proposed tariff that extended the pilot program and changed the administrative charge from \$0.084/Dth (dekatherm) to \$0.05/Dth. The administrative charge under the pilot program is trued up each year and a new charge is then established. The new charge falls below the cap set in the pilot program tariffs of \$0.25 and will be approved. The tariff filing was identified as TF-07-140.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The proposed tariff, TF-07-140, filed on July 27, 2007, by MidAmerican Energy Company is approved to become effective September 1, 2007.
