ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

(Issued September 27, 2007)

On September 17, 2007, AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha (collectively, AT&T) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a petition to intervene in this proceeding pursuant to 199 IAC 7.13. In support of its petition, AT&T states that it has an interest in the subject matter of the proceeding because AT&T uses access services from companies that concur in the Iowa Telecommunications Association's access tariff. AT&T states that any decision rendered by the Board regarding this issue will have a direct impact on AT&T's business interests.

The Board will grant AT&T's petition to intervene pursuant to 199 IAC 7.13. The Board finds that as a user of access services pursuant to this tariff, AT&T has demonstrated a sufficient interest in this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The petition to intervene filed by AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha on September 17, 2007, is granted.
