ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

(Issued October 23, 2007)

On October 16, 2007, Diane C. Browning, an out-of-state attorney representing Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) in this proceeding, filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request for admission to appear as attorney on behalf of Sprint. In support of her request, Ms. Browning states that she is licensed to practice law in Missouri, Kansas, and Texas and that she is a member in good standing of the bars of those jurisdictions. Ms. Browning states that Iowa attorney Nancy S. Boyd sponsors her request.

On October 17, 2007, Janette W. Luehring, an out-of-state attorney also representing Sprint in this proceeding, filed a request for admission to appear as attorney on behalf of Sprint. In support of her request, Ms. Luehring states that she

is licensed to practice law in Missouri and Kansas and is a member in good standing of the bars of those jurisdictions. Ms. Luehring states that Iowa attorney Nancy S. Boyd sponsors her request.

Also on October 17, 2007, Bret Lawson, an out-of-state attorney also representing Sprint in this proceeding, filed a request for admission to appear as attorney on behalf of Sprint. In support of his request, Mr. Lawson states that he is licensed to practice law in Kansas and is a member in good standing of the bar of that jurisdiction. Mr. Lawson states that Iowa attorney Nancy S. Boyd sponsors his request.

Each request appears to be in full compliance with 199 IAC 7.4(8) and includes the written appearance of an attorney admitted in Iowa, upon whom service may be made in all matters connected with this case pursuant to Iowa Supreme Court rule 31.14. The motions for admission pro hac vice will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The motions for admission pro hac vice filed by Sprint Communications Company L.P. on October 16 and October 17, 2007, are granted pursuant to 199 IAC 7.4(8).
