**ORDER AMENDING HEARING DATE**

(Issued November 8, 2007)

On October 26, 2007, the undersigned issued an "Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Proposing to Take Official Notice and Notice of Hearing." The order set the hearing date for Friday, December 7, 2007. Due to a scheduling conflict of the undersigned administrative law judge, the hearing date must be changed to Monday, December 10, 2007.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. All provisions of the "Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Proposing to Take Official Notice and Notice of Hearing," issued on October 26, 2007, remain in effect unless specifically modified by this order.
2. A public hearing for the presentation of evidence and the cross-examination of witnesses will be held beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, December 10, 2007, in the Assembly Room, First Floor, O'Brien County Courthouse, 155 South Hayes Avenue, Primghar, Iowa 51245. Each party must provide a copy of its prepared testimony and exhibits to the court reporter at the hearing. Ordinarily, parties and witnesses would have the opportunity to be connected to the hearing by

telephone conference call. However, telephone conference capability is not available in the room to be used for the hearing. Persons with disabilities who will require assistive services or devices to observe this hearing or participate in it should contact the Utilities Board (Board) at (515) 281-5256 no later than ten days prior to the hearing to request that appropriate arrangements be made.

3. Pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 17A.12(1) and 199 IAC 10.4, a copy of this order will be served by ordinary mail upon Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks (Aquila) and will be delivered to the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice. No person has filed an objection to the petition as of the date of this order.

4. Board staff will provide Aquila with a revised notice to be published and Aquila must publish the notice pursuant to Iowa Code § 479.7 and 199 IAC 10.4. The statute and rule require Aquila to file proof of publication prior to or at the beginning of the hearing. Since the hearing must be held in Primghar, Aquila must file proof of publication at least two days prior to the hearing date. Failure to publish notice and file proof of publication as required will result in delay of the hearing.
