ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(Issued November 19, 2007)

On November 8, 2007, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Iowa Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a "Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule" in this docket. In support of the motion, Consumer Advocate stated that it has negotiated with IPL a settlement of all issues in this case. Consumer Advocate also stated that the settlement agreement extends to the issues raised in Consumer Advocate's October 9, 2007, responsive pleading in *Interstate Power and Light Co.*, IUB Docket No. SPU-00-1, relating to Alliant Energy Corporate Services, Inc's Service Coordination and Operating Agreement (SCOA).

Consumer Advocate and IPL expect to file the settlement agreement no later than November 19, 2007, the same day Consumer Advocate is scheduled to file direct testimony.

The Board will suspend the procedural schedule contingent upon Consumer Advocate and IPL filing a settlement agreement by November 19, 2007. Consumer Advocate's request represents that none of the parties object to suspension of the

procedural schedule. The parties will be required to file a joint report regarding the status of settlement negotiations if no proposed settlement agreement has been filed with the Board on or before November 19, 2007.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The procedural schedule in Docket No. RPU-07-5 is suspended.
2. The parties shall file either a written settlement agreement or a joint report on the status of settlement negotiations on or before November 19, 2007.
