ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND ISSUING CERTIFICATE

(Issued December 26, 2007)

On November 5, 2007, Norlight, Inc. (Norlight), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed local exchange tariff providing the terms, conditions, and rates for local exchange service in Iowa in areas described in the local exchange maps of Qwest Corporation (Qwest). Revisions to the proposed tariff were filed on December 6 and 18, 2007. The proposed tariff and revision have been identified as TF-07-188.

On December 3, 2007, the Board issued an order in Docket No. TCU-07-6 approving Norlight's application to provide service in Iowa and approving its concurrence in Qwest's maps. The order stated that a certificate would be issued when Norlight obtained an approved tariff setting forth the prices, terms, and conditions of its proposed local exchange service in Iowa. Norlight requests the Board approve the proposed tariff and grant it a certificate to provide service in the listed exchanges.

The Board has reviewed the proposed tariff and its revisions and finds they substantially comply with Board rules for the filing and processing of tariff pages. The

tariff contains rates for both business and residential customers. Notice was provided to all affected carriers. The Board will approve the tariff effective the date of this order and will issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Norlight concurrent with this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The tariff filed by Norlight, Inc., on November 5, 2007, as revised on December 6 and 18, 2007, is approved, effective the date of this order.
2. A certificate, identified as Certificate No. 0321, is being issued to Norlight, Inc., concurrently with this order.
