**ORDER RESCHEDULING HEARING DATE AND  
AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

(Issued January 8, 2008)

On December 27, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in this docket granting a motion filed by Qwest Communications Corporation on December 21, 2007, to extend the procedural schedule in this proceeding. The Board's order rescheduled the hearing in this proceeding to August 4, 2008, and amended the procedural schedule to correspond with that extension.

Since the issuance of the December 27, 2007, order, the Board has learned of a scheduling conflict that will prevent the Board from hearing this matter during the weeks of August 4 and August 11, 2008. Therefore, the Board will reschedule the hearing in this matter to August 25, 2008. An amended procedural schedule will be established accordingly.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The procedural schedule in this docket is amended to reflect the following changes:
  - a. Qwest Communications Corporation (QCC) and any intervenors aligned with QCC shall file prepared direct testimony, with supporting exhibits and workpapers, on or before March 17, 2008.
  - b. Respondents and any intervenors aligned with them shall file rebuttal testimony, with supporting exhibits and workpapers, on or before June 16, 2008.
  - c. QCC and any intervenors aligned with QCC shall file reply testimony, with supporting exhibits and workpapers, on or before July 14, 2008.

d. A hearing for the purpose of receiving testimony and cross-examination of all testimony will commence at 9 a.m. on Monday, August 25, 2008, in the Board's hearing room, 350 Maple Street, Des Moines, Iowa. Parties shall appear at the hearing one-half hour prior to the time of hearing to mark exhibits. Persons with disabilities requiring assistive services or devices to observe or participate should contact the Board at 515-281-5256 to request appropriate arrangements.

e. Any party desiring to file a brief may do so on or before September 23, 2008.
