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ORDER REGARDING FERC FILING

(Issued January 30, 2008)

It has come to the attention of the undersigned administrative law judge that Alliant Energy Corporate Services, Inc. (AECS), on behalf of Wisconsin Power and Light Company and Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), filed an "Application Pursuant to Section 292.310(A) For Authorization to Terminate the Mandatory Purchase Obligation of Power from Qualified Facilities Over Twenty Megawatts on a Service Territory-Wide Basis" (Application) with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) on January 25, 2008. In the Application at page 9, AECS states that it provided a copy of the Application to the "Avoided cost proceedings in IA and WI."

This consolidated docket is the avoided cost proceeding in Iowa. AECS served a copy of the Application on the Executive Secretary of the Utilities Board (Board) on January 28, 2008, but did not include a cover letter or any other identifying information that told the Executive Secretary to file the Application in this consolidated docket. AECS also did not include an original and ten copies of the filing as is required in filings in this consolidated docket. Due to the normal filing procedures of the Board, the Application has therefore not been filed in this consolidated docket. In addition, it appears from the service list attached to the Application that AECS did not serve a copy of the application on the attorneys for the parties in this consolidated docket. The undersigned notes that Mr. Jeffrey M. Gray was the AECS attorney who filed the Application with FERC and served it on the Board. Attorney Ms. Paula N. Johnson represents IPL in this consolidated proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Interstate Power and Light Company shall file the Application with the Board in this consolidated docket and serve it as required by Board rules.
