ORDER REQUIRING ADDITIONAL FILING BY PARTIES

(Issued January 30, 2008)

On July 2, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an application pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 476A for a generating facility certificate to construct and operate a 630 MW coal-fired electric generating unit. The proposed unit is called the Sutherland Generating Station Unit Number 4 (SGS 4) and is to be located in Marshalltown, Marshall County, Iowa.

On January 14, 2008, a hearing commenced in Docket No. GCU-07-1, ending on January 18, 2008. During these proceedings, IPL, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice, and Plains Justice requested the Board take official notice of certain documents in accordance with Iowa Code § 17A.14(4). Iowa Code § 17A.14(4) states: "Official notice may be taken of all facts of which judicial notice may be taken and of other facts within the specialized knowledge of the agency" and that parties will be "afforded an opportunity to contest such facts before the decision is announced" Further, § 17A.12(6)"c" requires that the agency record include "a statement of all matters officially noticed."

During the hearing the Board took official notice of various documents requested by each party. Some of the requests were relatively specific, while others

were more broad and general in nature. The Board will now require all parties to file with the Board, simultaneously with each respective parties' post-hearing brief:

1. A list of the documents each party requested that the Board take official notice of in this docket;
2. The specific section, page number, or portion of each document each party requested the Board take official notice of in this docket, if the party does not request official notice of the entire document; and
3. A specification of where each document may be found and received by the public. This may be a location, such as the Board's Records and Information Center, or it may be a Web site or other source available to the public.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

On or before February 11, 2008, Interstate Power and Light Company, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice, and Plains Justice shall file the information specified in this order.
