ORDER APPROVING CHANGES TO EXCHANGE BOUNDARY MAPS

(Issued January 31, 2008)

On January 10, 2008, Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom (Iowa Telecom), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to change its exchange boundary map for the Fairbank, Iowa, exchange. The filing has been identified as TF-08-6.

Iowa Telecom's request proposes to transfer a limited area that is currently located in the Fairbank exchange to the Jesup, Iowa, exchange, currently served by Farmers Mutual Telephone Company (Farmers). Iowa Telecom states that two customers subscribe to service within the area of the proposed transfer. Iowa Telecom states that one customer receives service from both the Fairbank and Jesup exchanges, but recently constructed a new home and wishes to receive service from the Jesup exchange in his new home. Iowa Telecom asserts that it currently serves the other customer from the Fairbank exchange and will continue to do so while the

current customer resides at this residence. Iowa Telecom states that Farmers agrees to serve the location should a new customer move to this address.

On January 14, 2008, Farmers filed a corresponding request to revise its boundary map for the Jesup, Iowa, exchange. Farmers' request reflects the same customer's request to receive service from Farmers from the Jesup exchange in his new home. The filing is identified as TF-08-8.

The Board will approve the proposed changes to the Fairbank and Jesup exchange boundaries submitted by Iowa Telecom and Farmers pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.29(8). The Board finds the change is reasonable since the boundary revision was initiated at the request of an individual who is seeking service from Iowa Telecom and no other customers will be affected by the change. Both Iowa Telecom and Farmers have agreed to the boundary changes.

Iowa Telecom's and Farmers' requests merely change the boundaries of current exchanges covered by each party's certificate. Therefore, amended certificates are not needed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The request of Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom, filed on January 10, 2008, to change the exchange boundary map for the Fairbanks, Iowa, exchange is granted. A revised map for the Fairbanks, Iowa, exchange shall be filed with the Board within 30 days of the issuance of this order.

2. The request of Farmers Mutual Telephone Company filed on January 14, 2008, to change the exchange boundary map for the Jesup, Iowa, exchange is granted. A revised map for the Jesup, Iowa, exchange shall be filed with the Board within 30 days of the issuance of this order.

3. The proposed changes, identified as TF-08-6 and TF-08-8, are approved and become effective upon the issuance of this order.
