ORDER GRANTING RECONSIDERATION

(Issued February 14, 2008)

On December 26, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order denying a petition for a proceeding to consider a civil penalty for an alleged cramming violation filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate). Consumer Advocate alleged the violation was committed by GlobalYP.net (Global).

On January 15, 2008, Consumer Advocate filed a motion for reconsideration. The Board will consider the motion for reconsideration to be the equivalent of a request for rehearing. Pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.12, if the Board does not grant or refuse an application for rehearing within 30 days of filing, the application is deemed to be refused. Rather than allow this motion to be denied by operation of

law, the Board will grant the motion at this time solely for purposes of further consideration.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The "Motion For Reconsideration" filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice on January 15, 2008, is granted solely for purposes of further consideration.
