ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION AND ISSUING CERTIFICATE

(Issued February 14, 2008)

On January 30, 2008, Mediacom Iowa LLC, d/b/a Mediacom (Mediacom), filed an initial application for a certificate of franchise authority to provide cable service. Mediacom indicates it seeks a certificate of franchise authority as an incumbent cable provider as defined in 199 IAC 44.2, but notes it is not subject to an existing franchise agreement for the service area referred to in the application.

The application includes an affidavit signed by Mediacom's Vice President of Legal Affairs affirming that Mediacom has filed or will file with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) all forms required by the FCC before offering service in Iowa and that Mediacom agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state statutes, regulations, and rules, and with all applicable state laws and nondiscriminatory municipal ordinances and regulations regarding the use and occupation of a public right-of-way in the delivery of cable service, to the extent consistent with Iowa Code chapter 477A, including the police powers of the municipalities in which the service is delivered.

Mediacom's application includes the names and titles of its principal executive officers with direct authority over cable operations and provides customer service contact information.

In a manner consistent with Board subrule 44.3(3), Mediacom describes the service area and municipalities to be served. Specifically, Mediacom states that its cable service area includes all incorporated areas of Cresco, Fayette, Montrose, and New Sharon, Iowa, now in existence and as may be annexed in the future, as listed in Exhibit A attached to its application.

As required by Board rule 44.6, Mediacom attached a filing fee of \$100 to the application.

The Board has reviewed Mediacom's application and finds it complies with the Board's rules at 199 IAC 44. The Board will grant Mediacom's application for a certificate of franchise authority to provide cable service in the service area identified in Exhibit A attached to the application. The Board will issue Mediacom a certificate of franchise authority concurrent with this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The application for a certificate of franchise authority to provide cable service filed by Mediacom Iowa LLC, d/b/a Mediacom, on January 30, 2008, is granted.

2. A certificate of franchise authority, identified as Certificate No. C-0003, is issued to Mediacom Iowa LLC, d/b/a Mediacom, concurrently with this order.

**CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY
FOR INCUMBENT CABLE PROVIDER
PURSUANT TO 199 IAC 44**

Certificate of Franchise Authority Number: C-0003

This certificate grants the named cable service provider the following authority:

- ❖ To provide cable service in the service area designated below; and
- ❖ To use and occupy the public right-of-way in the delivery of cable service, subject to the laws of the State of Iowa, including the police powers of the municipalities in which the service is delivered.
