ORDER CLOSING DOCKET AND CANCELING HEARING

(Issued February 21, 2008)

This case was originally the subject of an informal complaint filed with the Utilities Board (Board) by Ms. Ann Bennett. Board staff investigated the complaint and issued a proposed resolution on February 7, 2007. On February 19, 2007, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a petition for a formal proceeding to consider a civil penalty for a cramming violation.

On January 28, 2008, the Board issued an order docketing this case as a formal proceeding and assigning it to the undersigned administrative law judge. On February 7, 2008, the undersigned issued an order setting the procedural schedule and hearing date. On February 19, 2008, the Consumer Advocate filed a withdrawal of the petition it had filed in this docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The hearing scheduled for Thursday, March 13, 2008, is hereby cancelled.
2. This docket is closed.
